Gdansk: Before and After



Seaman Will Keller was the radio operator on the *S. S. Park Victory* when the ship delivered 476 horses and 332 heifers to Gdansk, Poland, in January 1946. While the ship was docked from January 11 to 17, Will walked around Gdansk taking photographs of this once-beautiful Old World city destroyed by World War II. After the war, the city of Gdansk undertook the monumental task of rebuilding its town center as it had been before the war. In 2007, Will returned to Poland, camera in hand, and took photos of the same locations he had shot in 1946.

Print out Will's images on the sheets that follow, cut them apart, and match the 1946 image with its 2007 counterpart.
